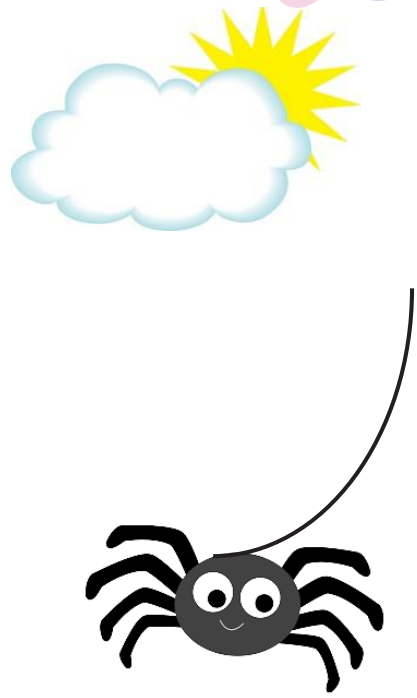

went up the spout again.

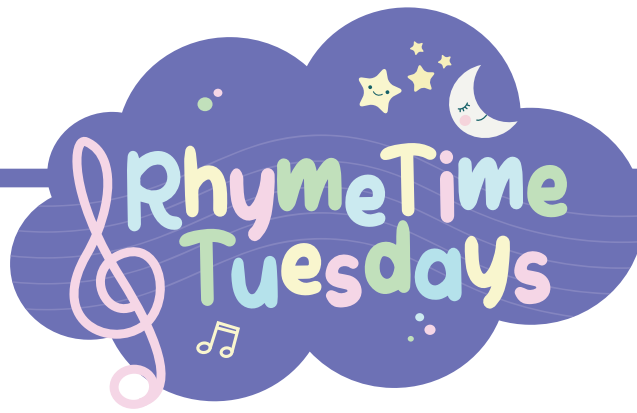

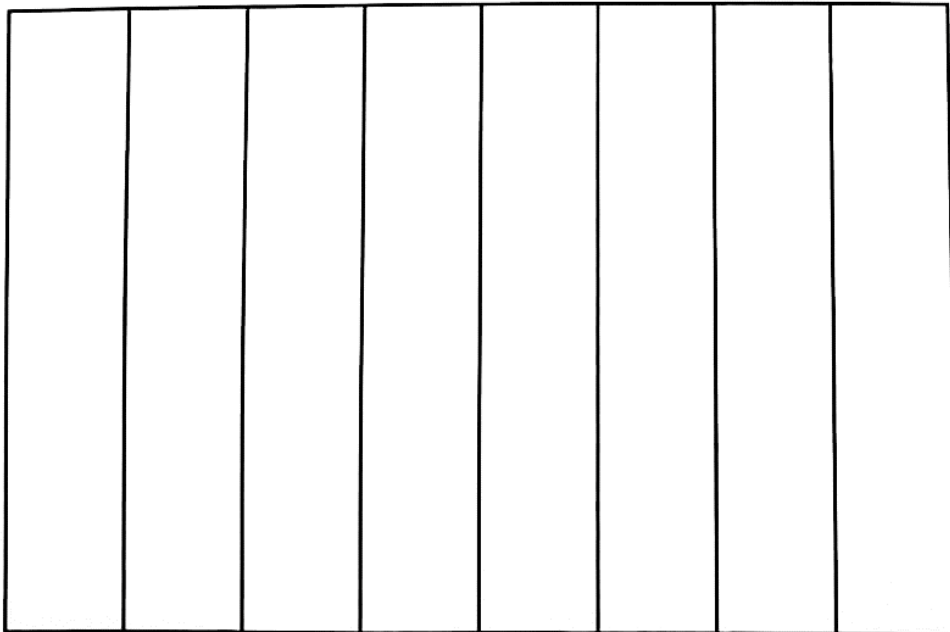
# CRAFT

## You will need:

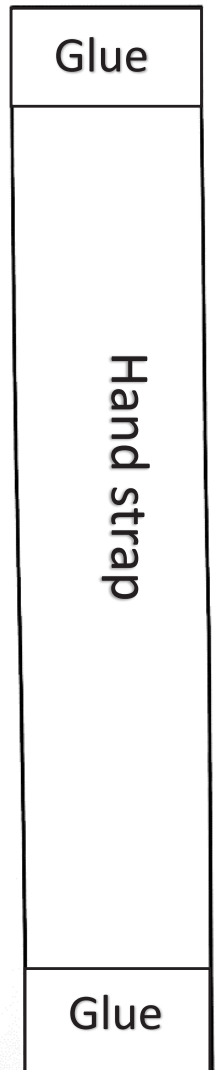
glue or tape  
markers, Crayons or black paper  
scissors

## Instructions:

1. Color and cut your spider puppet and legs, or trace your puppet and legs on black paper.
2. Fold the legs zig-zag or like a fan.
3. Glue or tape the eight legs to the spider's body.
4. Add glue or tape on each end of the hand strap and glue it to the underside of your puppet. Now you can hold your spider puppet.
